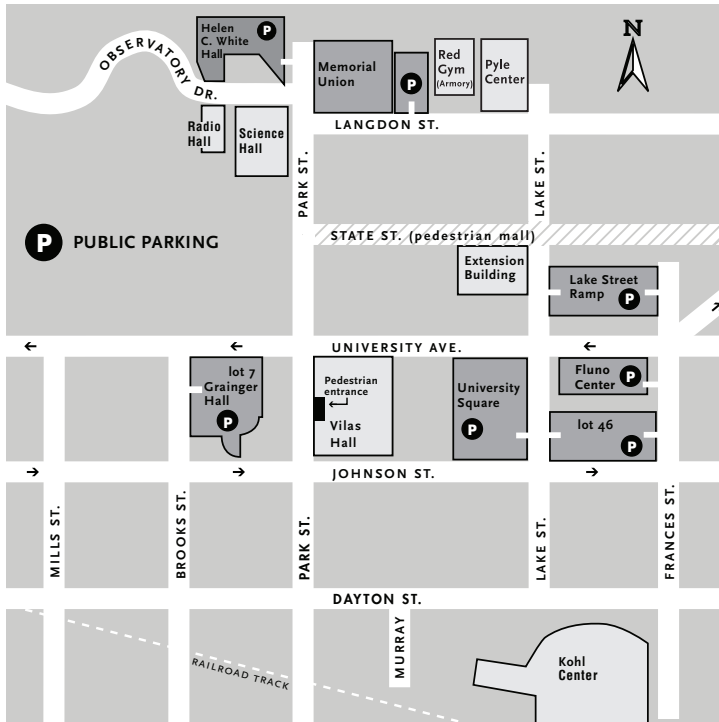

Getting to the Studio

The WPT Studio is in Vilas Hall, 821 University Ave., on the second floor. Enter down the stairs next to the loading dock entrance on the Park St. side of the building. Look for a banner pointing the way!

By Bus

Just about every bus route in the City goes past Vilas Hall, stopping at the corner of either Park St. and University Ave. or Park and Dayton Streets. Call Madison Metro at 266-4466 for schedule information. The last shifts run till about 11:00PM, so ask when the last bus runs on your route!

Parking (SEE MAP)

Lake St. Ramp, 415 N. Lake St.: Pay on exit, \$1.25/hr. \$5.00 maximum for hours after 6PM and on weekends. Takes Visa, MC, cash. During special events pay \$4.00 on entry.

Fluno Center, 601 University Ave.: Booth attendant 7AM-8:15PM weekdays and 7:15AM-8:45PM Saturdays. \$10.00/day, \$6.00 if entering after noon. Closed on Sunday.

Grainger Hall/UW Lot 7, 975 University Ave.: (closest to WPT) Booth attendant 7AM-8:15PM Mondays-Saturdays. \$10.00/day, \$6.00/day after noon. Morning permit (7-11AM) available for \$6.00. 2 hour meters on first level \$1.50/hr. *Lower level (past gate) FREE on Sundays.*

Southeast campus ramp/UW Lot 46, 301 N. Lake St.: (Lower levels only) 2, 4, 10 hr meters, \$1.50/hr. Enforced all times. Recommended during Kohl Center Events.

Kohl Center Events

During events at the Kohl Center parking will be tight, and lot 46 is recommended. Come early for a good spot. You can find out event dates by calling the Kohl Center info line at 263-KOHL.

Parking enforcement on campus is strict. All UW lots have enforcement signs at the entrance. Many lots are enforced at all times. Cars parked at expired meters are likely to receive a ticket! It is NOT generally possible to leave the studio in mid-shift to plug parking meters! *For more information on parking, call 263-6666 or visit www.fpm.wisc.edu/trans*
