Target words: architect, athlete, barber, dancer, doctor, inventor, meteorologist, musician, nurse, veterinarian, firefighter, teacher, farmer, zoo keeper, taxi driver, judge, police officer

Materials: vocabulary cards

Directions: This acting game is like Charades but with talking allowed.

1. Make your own vocabulary cards with the target words or a picture of the word.
2. Go through the cards with the kids, introducing and discussing each word, then shuffle the cards and place them in a hat.
3. One person picks a card and pretends to be that word. That person cannot say the name of the job aloud, but must act it out. The other players have to guess what that person is.
