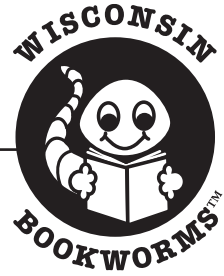


WISCONSIN BOOKWORMS™

"The Letters are Lost" By Lisa Campbell Ernst

Wooden alphabet blocks, with one letter to a block, were once together in their box. But now they've all gone astray. Where are they? Well, the A is in an airplane, the B has tumbled into the bath, and the L has landed in a pile of leaves. Come along on a search for all of the letters.

Before you read this book: Sing the ABC song. Talk about lost things. Have you ever lost something? What did you lose? Where did you find it? Share stories of items you've lost.

While you read this book: Have the children read each letter as you point to it or you can read each letter together. Sing the ABC song together at the end, pointing to each block as you sing.

After you read this book: Identify the first letter (or each letter) of each child's name. "Find" that block in the book.

Try this at home: Take a walk outside. "Find" the letters throughout your neighborhood. For example, "T climbed up a tree" or "D ran down the drain."

Enjoy more books by the same author: "The Gingerbread Girl," "Zinnia and Dot," "Up to Ten and Down Again," "Cat's Play," "Round Like a Ball," "Walter's Tail," "Good Morning, Sun!" and "Wake Up, It's Spring!"
